MONDAY: TAKEN FROM “JOY FOR THE JOURNEY” By Timothy Peck...I John 1:1-7

KEY VERSE: I John 1:6-7

OBSERVATION: Here are four factors we need in order to have genuine joy in our spiritual journey today.

1. Building on the right foundation (I John 1:1-2) **2.** Having the right companions. (I John 1:3-4) **3.** Having the right source (I John 1:5; Psalm 119:105. Psalm 119:130); **4.** Having the right goal (I John 1:6-7) Do you have these four attributes active in your life? If not, which one(s) are missing?

TUESDAY: I John 1:8-2:2

KEY VERSE: I John 1:8

OBSERVATION: WE ALL STRUGGLE: *“Being a Christian is more than just an instantaneous conversion. It is a **daily process** whereby you grow to be **more and more like Christ.**”* Billy Graham What are you struggling with? Are you making progress or do you feel defeated? Do you think you are the only one who is wrestling with this issue? Who have you confided with and will encourage you and pray with you?

WEDNESDAY: I John 1:9; Proverbs 28:13; Psalm 32:1-5

KEY VERSE: Proverbs 28:13

OBSERVATION: CONFESSION BRINGS CLEANSING: *“And that's the great thing about living the Christian life and trying to live by faith, is you're trying to get a little better every day. You're trying to improve. How long does it take you to confess you're sins? You know your sins. God knows your sins. What is the holdup?”*

THURSDAY: I John 1:10; Galatians 1:13; I Timothy 1:12-17

KEY VERSE: I Timothy 1:15

OBSERVATION: GOD KNOWS OUR PAST: God knows your past even better than you do. He loves you anyway. Satan knows your past and he wants to accuse you. Satan does not love you at all. The next time Satan reminds you of your past remind him of his future.

FRIDAY: I John 2:1-2; Romans 3:25-26; I John 2:3-11

KEY VERSE: I John 2:1-2

OBSERVATION: JESUS IS ENOUGH: *“One encounter with Jesus Christ is enough to change you instantly, forever.”* Luis Palau. Make a list of the various ways Jesus has changed your life and is still changing your life.

SATURDAY: 2 Corinthians 2:12-17

KEY VERSE: 2 Corinthians 2:17

OBSERVATION: GOD CALLS US TO AUTHENTICITY WITH EACH OTHER BECAUSE JESUS CHRIST IS GODS' PROVISION FOR ALL SIN. Evaluate yourself as a Christian: **1.** Authentic. **2.** Part Time. **3.** For show only. **4.** Other
