

The Chapel Family Bible Reading Program – April 11-16
“Those who leave everything in God's hands will eventually see God's hand in everything.”

MONDAY: John 13:1-30

KEY VERSE: John 13:1

OBSERVATION: God has perfect **timing**; never early, never late. It takes patience and a lot of faith. But it's worth it. *“Trust God's **timing**. He makes all things beautiful in His **time**.”* Sarah Wehrli. Why did Jesus wait for this moment to tell His disciples about His betrayal and death? When did Jesus know this time would come? Have you ever missed God's timing by doing something **too soon** or **too late** ?

TUESDAY: Hebrews 4:14-16; Isaiah 40:28-31; Psalm 130:5-8; Galatians 6:9; Hebrews 11:1

KEY VERSE: Hebrews 4:16

OBSERVATION: Stress makes you believe everything has to happen right now. Faith reassures you that everything will happen in **God's timing**. *“Timing is everything. The things you are praying for will show up when you are most ready for them.”* Mandy Hale. The word **wait** in the Bible means *“confident expectation”* and the word **hope** means *“to look expectantly”*. How do you define them?

WEDNESDAY: Exodus 3:20-21; 2 Timothy 3:16-17

KEY VERSE: 2 Timothy 3:17

OBSERVATION: A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone, when he/she is fully **trained** will be like his teacher. If you are **not willing** to learn, no one can help you. If you are **willing** to learn, no one can stop you. Do you agree with both of these statements? Explain. Are you practicing these disciplines and applying them in your everyday life?

THURSDAY: Hebrews 12:9-11; Ephesians 6:4-9; Psalm 22:6

KEY VERSE: Hebrews 6:7

OBSERVATION: *“Tell me and I forget. Teach me and I remember. **Involve me and I learn**.”* Benjamin Franklin. *“The Christian religion is important and one of the first things in which all children, under a free government, ought to be **instructed**.”* Noah Webster. At what point in life a Christian stop being trained? **1.** After High School. **2.** At the age of 40. **3.** When you retire. **4.** Never.

FRIDAY: 2 Peter 2:1-10; 2 Timothy 3:1-5; Matthew 10:16-23

KEY VERSE: 2 Peter 2:1

OBSERVATION: *“We laugh at honor and are shocked to find traitors in our midst.”* C.S. Lewis. *“Better an honest enemy than a false friend.”* German Proverb. Have you ever betrayed someone? Has someone ever betrayed you? How did you feel and how did you respond when you were betrayed? Have you ever betrayed the Lord? How did He respond?

SATURDAY: John 13:1-11; 2 Chronicles 7:14; 1 Peter 5:5; Mark 10:45; Philippians 2:5-8

KEY VERSE: Mark 10:45

OBSERVATION: *“God does not want you to become a 'God' – He wants you to become godly - taking on His values, attitudes and character.”* Rick Warren. Consider the following patterns of being a servant: **Humility, Helpfulness, Holiness**. Jesus lived these three things as an example for us to follow. On a scale of 1-10 how would you grade yourself on each of these? How might you improve?
