MONDAY: Job 19:25-27; Psalm 42:1-2

KEY VERSE: Job 19:27

OBSERVATION: *“When I stand before God at the end of my life, I hope that I will not have a single bit of talent left, and could say, I used everything you gave me.”* Erma Bombeck. Are you certain that if you were to die today you would go to heaven? How about your co-workers; friends; neighbors? Are you a light shining in darkness? Are you making every effort to accomplish the plan God has for you?

TUESDAY: Psalm 23:1-6

KEY VERSE: Psalm 23:6

OBSERVATION: *“To get through the hardest journey we need to take only one step at a time, but we must keep on stepping.”* Think of a time in your life when you became frustrated, discouraged or tired and you gave up. Think of a time in your life when everything was going wrong and you worked your way through. Which is the better memory? Why do you suppose that God allows us to go through difficult times?

WEDNESDAY: Romans 6:15-23; Galatians 6:7-10

KEY VERSE: Galatians 6:9

OBSERVATION: *“I judge all things by the price they shall gain in eternity.”* John Wesley. We should judge all things by the price they shall gain in eternity....Eternal Life; Freedom From Sin; Authority; Power; Status; Ability; Opportunity To Serve; Relationships; Rest In Christ. THURSDAY: John 3:16-21; I Corinthians 2:9-10

KEY VERSE: John 3:16

FRIDAY: Romans 8:35-39

KEY VERSE: Romans 8:37

SATURDAY: Hebrews 12:1-13

KEY VERSE: Hebrews 12:1
