

**The Chapel Family Bible Reading Program June 27-July 2**  
***“Humility Is Not Thinking Less Of Yourself, It's Thinking Of Yourself Less.” Rick Warren***

**MONDAY: 2 Chronicles 7:14; Psalm 51: 12-17; I Peter 5:6-7**

**KEY VERSE: 2 Chronicles 7:14**

**OBSERVATION: “A humble heart, combined with worship, always equals strength to keep going.” Humility starts in prayer – in your heart as you approach God. That does not mean that when you pray you are automatically humble, but that you become humble when you pray. The FIRST need when praying is to humble ourselves. Pastor Craig Ledbetter. Do you consider yourself to be a humble person? How would you rate your humility? Define humility? HOW can you improve?**

**TUESDAY: Matthew 6:5-6; Luke 18:9-14**

**KEY VERSE: Luke 18:13**

**OBSERVATION: PRAYER IS TO BE HUMBLING. Not everyone humbles themselves when they pray. The Pharisees didn't. But God's people must humble themselves, if they want God to even HEAR their prayers. You will waste your time praying if you have a hard heart towards God, or towards people! GOD REQUIRES: 1. A soft heart (2 King 22:19). 2. A submitted heart (Exodus 10:3; James 4:6-7). 3. A seeking heart (Deut. 4:29) How are you doing in living out these three “S” words?**

**WEDNESDAY: Proverbs. 16:7; I John 5:15; I Peter 5:6; Isaiah 57:15**

**KEY VERSE: I John 5:15**

**OBSERVATION: THE PROMISED BLESSING OF HUMBLING OURSELVES: 1. Removal of judgment and troubles. 2. God hears us. 3. We have answers to our requests. 4. God will honor us. 5. We will experience revival. Are you fully experiencing Gods' PROMISED BLESSINGS? If not, why not?**

**THURSDAY: 1 Corinthians 11:28; Psalm 139:23, 24; 2 Peter 2:14**

**KEY VERSE: Psalm 139:23-24**

**OBSERVATION: How to humble yourself. 1. PRIVATE CONFESSION - Be honest with God. 2. PERSONAL CONFESSION – Face to face with the ones you have hurt. 3. PUBLIC CONFESSION – public sins require public confession. “Gods' promises are all on condition of humble obedience.” How long does it take to confess your sins? Why wait?**

**FRIDAY: Psalm 100:4-5; Colossians 3:16; Philippians 2:6-8**

**KEY VERSE: Psalm 100:4-5**

**OBSERVATION: CULTIVATING HUMILITY IN PRAYER: 1. Have a grateful heart. 2. Have a worshiping heart. 3. Have an abandoned heart. Have you implemented these into your daily life? If so, is there room for improvement?**

**SATURDAY: John 13:3-17; Mark 10:45; Philippians 2:3-5**

**KEY VERSE: Mark 10:45**

**OBSERVATION: CULTIVATING HUMILITY IN PRAYER #: 1. Have a servant's heart. (Jesus was the servant of all). 2. Have a considerate heart. Simple acts of humility will make a difference in a world that esteems headhunting and self promotion. Jesus is our great example. He is out to win our hearts for love. Do you have a servant's and considerate heart? Is there room to grow?**
