

The Chapel Family Bible Reading Program – March 27-April 1
Doing Life Together – Rock Church – We Worship YOU!

MONDAY: Philippians 3:3, Psalm 145:18, John 4:23

KEY VERSE: John 4:23-24

OBSERVATION God seeks true worshippers, and He identifies them as those who "worship Him in spirit and in truth". Worshipping God in spirit means that it must be done from the heart. Worshipping God in truth means that it must be done according as God has specified in the Bible. Worshipping God in spirit and in truth is a serious matter which must not be taken lightly. If we have any regard for our own souls, we will want to make sure we are worshipping God in spirit and in truth.

TUESDAY: 2 Corinthians 7:15, Hebrews 5:9, Philippians 1:6

KEY VERSE: Philippians 2:12

OBSERVATION: Our salvation is a very serious matter and will not happen by accident. We must work it out "with fear and trembling". Our salvation depends on whether our worship is pleasing to God or not. On the Day of Judgment it will be too late to make any corrections. Worship should cause us to reflect on the majesty and graciousness of God and Christ, contrasted to our own unworthiness. God does not have to have our worship, but we must worship Him to please Him. Our singing, praying, studying His word, giving, and communion are designed by God to bring us closer to Him and to cause us to think more like He thinks, thus becoming more like Him.

WEDNESDAY: Psalm 50:14, Hosea 14:2, Romans 12:1-2

KEY VERSE: Hebrews 13:15

OBSERVATION: In worship we must be the participants, not the observers. We want to please and entertain ourselves. In Galatians 1:10 the question is asked, "Do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a servant of Christ." Worship is God-centered not man-centered. When our worship is to please God instead of ourselves, then and only then will our worship be much more meaningful and spiritually uplifting to us and acceptable to God.

THURSDAY: 1 Corinthians 10:7, 1 John 2:1, 1 Thessalonians 1:9

KEY VERSE: 1 John 5:21

OBSERVATION: If we worship God in spirit and in truth, we cannot worship anyone or anything else. Anything we worship, other than God, is an idol. According to Webster, an idol is "an image used as an object or instrument of worship." God forbids us to make and worship idols.

FRIDAY: Proverbs 10:3, Ecclesiastes 10:2, Isaiah 33:6

KEY VERSE: Matthew 6:33

OBSERVATION: Going to heaven has got to be our first priority in our life or we probably will not make it. We will not accidentally end up in Heaven. Heaven is too great and glorious to miss. It will be beyond our greatest expectations. There is no way to visualize how wonderful it will be. Don't you want to go there? Please don't miss it. If we miss Heaven the only other place for us is eternal punishment, which is horrible and beyond description.

SATURDAY: Matthew 22:37, Exodus 23:25, 1 Timothy 1:5

KEY VERSE: Deuteronomy 10:12-13

OBSERVATION: This is what God requires of us, both in our obedience and worship of Him. We must worship God in spirit and in truth, if we really want to go to heaven.
