Doing Life Together – Doing Life Together

MONDAY:

KEY VERSE: Isaiah 55:8

OBSERVATION: His thoughts and His ways are so much higher than ours. Does this mean we can't think like the Lord? No, because through the Word of God we have the mind of Christ. The Word elevates our thinking up to God's level of where we see things and think like God does.

TUESDAY:

KEY VERSE: James 3:4

OBSERVATION: The Christian life is not like a very small boat or a sea-doo which can stop suddenly or turn quickly and head in the opposite direction. It is more like a huge barge that needs time to turn around. As your mind is renewed every day the process of turning your words and actions begin to conform to the ways of God.

WEDNESDAY:

KEY VERSE: Romans 12:1

OBSERVATION: Reasonable service refers to spiritual worship. When we present our bodies daily to God, it is our spiritual act of worship. When we praise, we thank God for what He's given. When we worship, we return something back. God changes us each and every day from the inside to where the world can press all it wants to and it will not affect us. Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world.

THURSDAY:

KEY VERSE: Romans 12:2

OBSERVATION: Worldliness starts with how you think. There are certain behaviors that indicate your thoughts are worldly, and God wants us to avoid those behaviors. Thoughts are what cause you to be worldly. Thoughts are what cause you to be godly.

FRIDAY:

KEY VERSE: Philippians 4:8

OBSERVATION: God wants us to wrap our thought life around the things of God. This produces a godly lifestyle. When you conquer the thought life, the natural life takes care of itself. Worldly thinking is "What am I wearing?", "How do I look?", "How am I acting?" When our mind is focused on the things of God these things take care of themselves.

SATURDAY:

KEY VERSE: Colossians 3:1,2

OBSERVATION: Born again, children of God are seated with Jesus Christ in heavenly places – need to think like it! Seek those things which are above. We are called to set our minds on things above, not on things on the earth. Every day you have a choice to think on things above; Heavenly things, things that are powerful, things of the Spirit, the promises of God, success and not failure, the power in you to overcome Satan, demons and the forces of this earth, the confidence you will come out a victor on the other side because God has promised it.
